

Privacy Notice – Curricular Swimming

Information held about you

We will collect the information on this form; name and contact information including school, telephone numbers, email, postal address, date of birth and medical conditions to register on the Curricular Swimming programme.

Who is processing my data?

All personal information is held and processed by West Lothian Council in accordance with data protection law.

How will we use information we hold about you?

We will use the information to appropriately plan for, and register attendance at, curricular swimming sessions.

Who we will share your information with?

Information will be shared with West Lothian Leisure to enable them to assess swimming proficiency as part of the curricular swimming programme. Parents/guardians of pupils who have been assessed as non-swimmers will receive an invite from West Lothian Leisure to take part in swimming lessons during holiday periods.

How long do we keep your records?

Information will be kept for a period of 18 months.

Your Rights

How you can see the information we hold?

You have a right to request your information and, in some cases, ask for it to be changed or deleted. To request your records, you will need to put your request in writing and provide proof of identification to West Lothian Council, West Lothian Civic Centre, Howden South Road, Livingston, West Lothian, EH54 6FF.
